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## The Crossways Logo

The cross of Jesus sits centrally within the logo with diagonal lines intersecting it to represent the Crossways Religious Education curriculum as an integration of faith, life and culture.

All lines are drawn to the centre to create a circle and this intersection can represent many things:

- students learning in dialogue with each other
- the partnerships between the school, parish and broader Church in the life and mission of the Church
- the family as first and foremost educators of faith
- that together, we are the body of Christ
- working together to be leaders for the world God desires.

The open space in the middle can be interpreted in many ways:

- the hermeneutical space of encounter in the RE classroom
- a place of growth in faith, knowledge and identity
- the space in our midst in which the mystery of God dwells
- the opportunity for evangelisation, where students hear and respond to the call of the Gospel to proclaim and live the Reign of God.

The colours used have been chosen purposefully; the navy is CESA blue and the teal is the colour of the CESA's *Key Capability: Spiritually Aware and Inspired by Faith*.
